Last November MUD 113 entered into an agreement with Montgomery County Commissioners for the Sheriff's Department to provide two full-time deputies for security patrol within the District. This service is in addition to the routine patrolling that takes place in unincorporated areas across the County and targeted additional surveillance of the Fish Creek Thoroughfare. The new deputies report through Captain Melvin Franklin, who heads up the Patrol West Division, and Lt. Brady Fitzgerald. They are fully certified as peace officers and meet all training requirements of the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement.

Please welcome our deputies, Stanley Jolly and Kevin Douglas. Stan is a 23-year veteran of the Harris County Precinct 4 Constable's Office. He is married with five grown children. Kevin has five years' experience with the Sheriff's Department and is married with three young children. MUD 113 has recently contracted Municipal Operations & Consulting, Inc. (M.O.C.) to operate the Wastewater Treatment Plant and related operations for the District. Beginning in March, customers will receive a separate bill for Wastewater/Garbage Services from MOC in the amount of \$47.55. M.O.C. replaces Mid-South Synergy (MSEC), who announced their intention to withdraw from this business last fall. MSEC will continue to supply the electric and water needs of the District.
