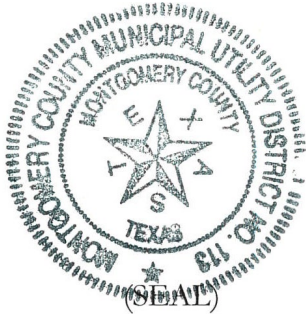
MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 113
