## **Keep Woodforest Safe**

### **Shooting Range**

At the October, 2018 Board Meeting residents reported concern over hearing frequent gunshots to the east of the retention ponds. The Board of Directors requested the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and the District's legal counsel investigate (i) where the gunshots were coming from and (ii) if the entity firing the shots were following the law.

It was determined that the gunshots were coming from a 15 acre tract next to Woodforest and behind Christine Allen Nature Park, owned by KBA Defense, LLC. This property is not within the boundaries of Woodforest or MUDs 113/121. Furthermore, it is the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and the District's legal counsel opinion that neither the City of Conroe nor Montgomery County have the authority to regulate any activities on the new shooting range based on statutory protections afforded sports shooting ranges by the Texas Legislature. The Montgomery County Sheriff's Office reiterate that if a resident at any time feels unsafe, scared, or threatened with regards to the gunfire to call them and they will investigate the matter.

### **Safety Tips for the Holidays**

The Sheriff's Office asked us to remind residents to be careful this Holiday Season and to be aware of your surroundings. It is very important not to leave packages, valuables, or cash in your car. Also, when visiting a bank to withdraw cash, do not leave the bank with cash or an envelope containing cash clearly visible.

### **Suspicious Activity/Vehicle**

The community has been very alert and helpful to law enforcement regarding reporting of suspicious activity or vehicles in the District. The Sheriff's Office wants to reinforce that residents should call the Montgomery Sherriff's Office and not approach suspicious individuals or vehicles.
