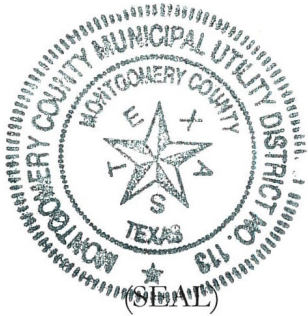
### MONTGOMERY COUNTY MUNICIPAL UTILITY DISTRICT NO. 113


The Board of Directors of Montgomery County Municipal Utility District No. 113 will hold a regular meeting on **Monday, February 18, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., at 101 Elk Trace Parkway, Montgomery, Texas 77316**, to discuss and, if appropriate, act upon the following items:

  - e. permits, deeds, easements, consents to encroachment, and utility commitment letters, renewal of wastewater discharge permit;
  - f. update on Ridge Lake Shores Dam, and authorize execution of letter to Montgomery County regarding dam safety evaluation; and
  - g. engineering proposals for Road Improvement Bonds, Series 2019 and Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2019A.
